Lead line Division

2. Lead line Pleasure – walk / halt / 2pt / answer question from judge
3. Lead line EQ – walk / trot (briefly) halt / back

TEAM CHALLENGE: Each team must consist of 2 or more riders, but no more than 4. The team MUST send one team member into the following classes: **Class 7 Mounted Obstacles, Class 21 Bridle Path Hack, Class 27 Equitation U/S and Class 101 WEC Hopeful Jumper**. If your team has less than 4, one team member must compete in more than one of the selected team challenge classes. Each team member must compete in at least one of the Team Classes. The winning team will be determined by the total sum of all of their points based on their placing in the team classes. **PRIZE \$100** an award for each member, PLUS bragging rights!

THOROUGHBRED ONLY DIVISION: This division is restricted to Thoroughbreds only. Proof of eligibility requirements: TIP number or breed recorded on current Coggins.

ENTRIES: Entries must be emailed to BGHorseShowEntries@gmail.com. Exhibitors may make electronic payments via Zelle, Venmo or Paypal.

RULES: USEF, rules apply. **SHOW ATTIRE IS PREFERRED, BOOTS AND HELMETS ARE REQUIRED!**

FEES: Please refer to the fee schedule located on the other side of this form. There is a price break for entering in an entire division, however, it is more cost effective to enter by the class for Obstacles, Hunter Pleasure or the Jumper divisions

PAYMENTS: Remit payment via Venmo, Zelle or Paypal. After the entry is received, the show secretary will send you a link via email...

DUE TO THE HIGH COSTS OF THE VENUE, EQUIPMENT, PRIZES AND CONTRACTING A JUDGE, Treasure Coast Equestrian Events and BG Equestrian asks that **pre-entry packages, including payments BE RECEIVED by Dec. 2, 2023** to guarantee your entry. SCHOOLING: Exhibitors/owners MUST check in with the administration booth and get their show packages upon arrival. BG Equestrian and/or Treasure Coast Equestrian Events Management **MUST have an entry, signed liability release, proof of negative coggins, and payment,** PRIOR to exhibitors stabling and/or riding their horse(s) on the premises. **BACK NUMBERS:** Must be worn while all times when mounted, and showing, if lost during the show, please request a new one.
